The next day, Mama took Sister to the Bear Country Bank to put her money in an account so she could save it for later. The bank pays her interest for keeping her money in her account.

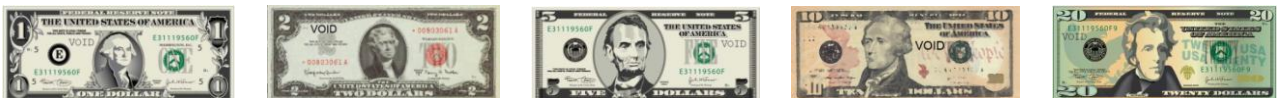
